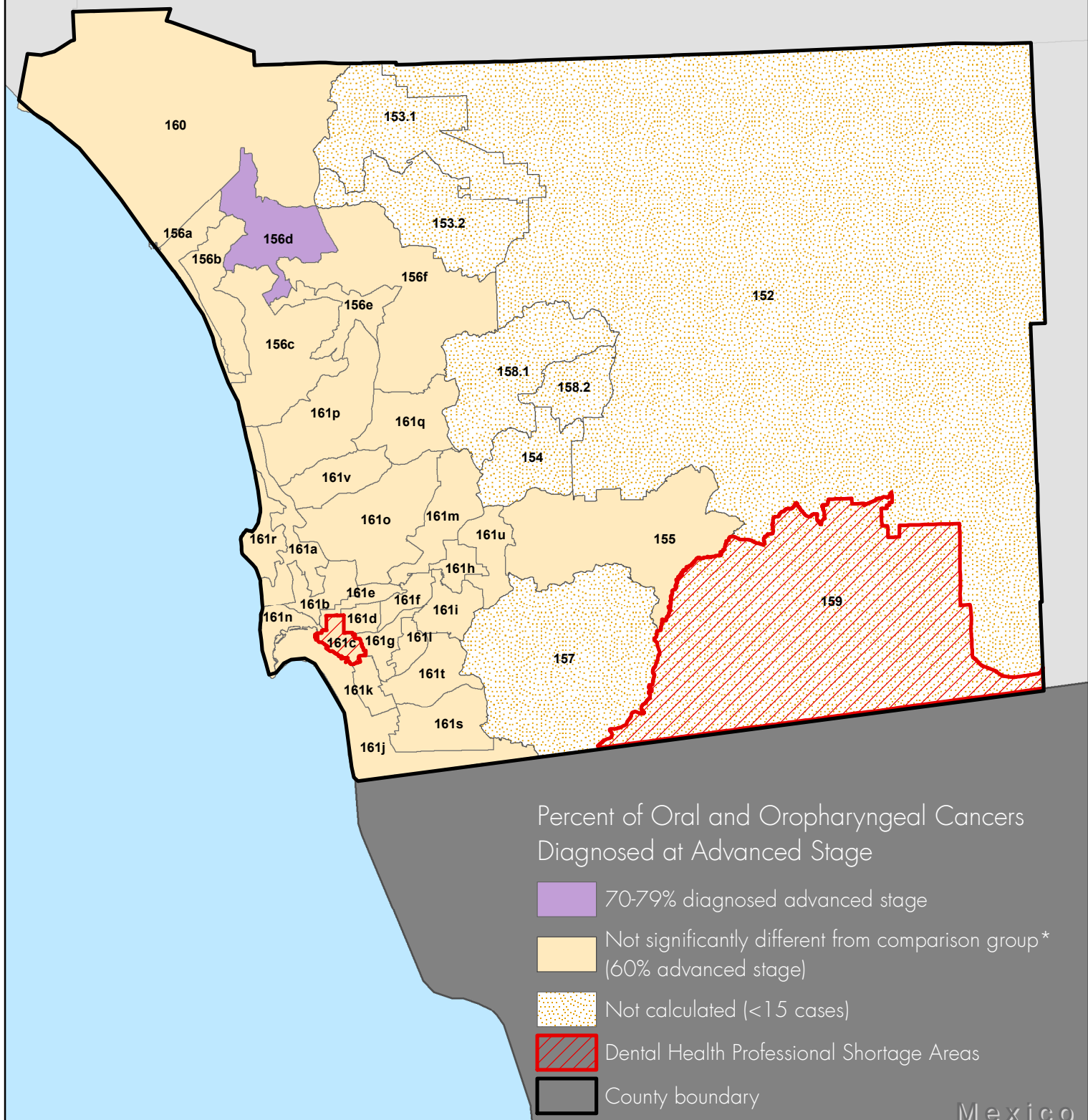


Advanced Stage Oral and Oropharyngeal Cancers in San Diego County Communities Among Adults 20 Years and Older, 2008-2012



- Percent of Oral and Oropharyngeal Cancers Diagnosed at Advanced Stage
- 70-79% diagnosed advanced stage
 - Not significantly different from comparison group* (60% advanced stage)
 - Not calculated (<15 cases)
 - Dental Health Professional Shortage Areas
 - County boundary
- Mexico

* Comparison group includes non-Hispanic whites living in high socioeconomic areas. This group was chosen because they had the lowest proportion of oral and oropharyngeal cancers diagnosed advanced stage.
