REVISED - AJCC Edit Resolution

Due to the high number of issues that will be resolved with NAACCR v16B and C metafiles, please delay reporting any issues until your vendor has distributed the updated metafile.

If after uploading v16B and 16C metafiles, you suspect an edit error, please follow these steps:

- 1. Determine if the problem is a coding issue or an edit issue. Consider checking CAnswer Forum and SEER SINQ to see if the issue has been reported and a fix recommended.
- 2. If you think your coding is correct and believe there is a problem with the edit, please report this to your regional registry.
 - a. Do not submit edit issues to the CAnswer forum or SEER Ask a CTR.
 - b. Always include the following information when reporting an edit issue to your region:
 - i. Edit Name
 - ii. Error Message Received
 - iii. Description of all related fields and how they are coded
- 3. If regional staff are unable to resolve the edit and/or agree there is an edit issue, they will contact the CCR by submitting a ZenDesk ticket.
- 4. CCR staff will review the issue and forward it to NAACCR Edits Work Group Chair, Jim Hofferkamp. He will work with the Edits Work Group to determine the appropriate solution.
- 5. If there is an edit problem, CCR will provide options on how to proceed until an updated edits metafile is distributed.
 - a. If the Edits Work Group determines that it is a coding issue, they will provide a coding solution to the CCR which the CCR will communicate to all regional abstractors.
