SEER*Rx-Interactive Drug Database
Released September 30, 2014

SEER*Rx has made some modifications by improving their search engine. The search engine performs faster and more intelligent full text searching of all fields, with a sortable results table and a new relevance column that tells how relevant each search result is to the entered search string. Each drug and regimen is now displayed in its own page so that specific entries can be bookmarked.

The web-based version of the SEER*Rx is the preferred method to access the current data. If the software version is preferred due to limited Internet access, it is still available for now, but may be phased out in the future.
