2010 DATA CHANGES ALERT

AJCC Seventh Edition Cancer Staging Manual and Handbook Errata

Since the publication of the seventh edition of the AJCC Cancer Staging Manual, important updates and clarifications have been noted, as well as some unintended technical inaccuracies and typographical errors.

Content changes that affect staging are few and include the following:

- **Colon and Rectum:** The circumferential resection margin image was mislabeled and should be T3;R2 on the right side.
- **Prostate:** For stage IIA, add T2a N0 M0 PSA \geq 10<20 Gleasons \leq 6 and change the T2a line to read T2a N0 M0 PSA<20

Gleason7.

- **Testis:** The serum tumor markers used in staging should all be measured post-orchietomy.

All of these errors have been corrected in the July 2010 reprint of the seventh edition manual and handbook. The front matter of these publications will state, "Corrected with 5th reprint (2010)".
