Subject: Reportability: VIN, VAIN, and AIN Cases

Effective: Cases Diagnosed 1/1/2012 forward

Per SEER Coding and Staging Manual 2012, effective with cases diagnosed 1/1/2012 forward, cases described as the following are **not reportable**:

- Anal Intraepithelial Neoplasia II/III, Anal Intraepithelial Neoplasia II-III
 - (may also be stated as AIN II/III, AIN II-III, AIN 2/3 or AIN 2-3)
- Vaginal Intraepithelial Neoplasia II/III, Vaginal Intraepithelial Neoplasia II-III
 - (may also be stated as VAIN II/III, VAIN II-III, VAIN 2/3 or VAIN 2-3)
- Vulvar Intraepithelial Neoplasia II/III, Vulvar Intraepithelial Neoplasia II-III
 - (may also be stated as VIN II/III, VIN II-III, VIN 2/3 or VIN 2-3)

The record or pathology report must specifically state one of the following terms for the case to be reportable:

- Anal Intraepithelial Neoplasia III (may also be stated as AIN III or AIN 3)
- Vaginal Intraepithelial Neoplasia III (may also be stated as VAIN III or VAIN 3)
- Vulvar Intraepithelial Neoplasia III (may also be stated as VIN III or VIN 3)

Anal carcinoma in situ, vaginal carcinoma in situ, and vulvar carcinoma in situ are still considered reportable and are not affected by this policy change.
