



Quality Control Unit Data Alert – 2022-15 Timeliness Extension – 2022 Cases

As of 08/19/2022, the California Cancer Registry (CCR) does not have any approved software vendors for the transmission of records with a 2022 Date of Diagnosis. Due to these delays, the CCR Timeliness requirements for **cases diagnosed in 2022** is suspended until January 2023 and will be re-evaluated at that time. The CCR Timeliness suspension applies to all reporting facilities.

Future Data Alerts will be distributed when software vendors are approved, and subsequent timeliness requirements are reinstated.

Note: Any case with a Date of First Contact of 2021 or earlier is still subject to the CCR Timeliness requirement standard as described in Volume I, Timeliness-Quality Control. Cases first seen at a reporting facility in 2022, but diagnosed prior to January 1, 2022 are also subject to the normal timeliness standard requirements. At this time, these cases should be abstracted using the current v21 software for pre-2022 diagnosed cases and transmitted accordingly. No timeliness requirement exclusion will be applied to these cases.
