



Quality Control Unit Data Alert – 2025-03 FLccSC is Back on-line!

Message from the Florida Cancer Data System: The FCDS is pleased to announce that the FLccSC systems are back on-line. We are truly sorry for the inconvenience our downtime has caused you and your facilities.

Some items to be aware of:

- 1. New passwords will be required the first time you log into FLccSC.
- 2. The passwords must meet a minimum of the following:
 - a. Be at least eight (8) characters
 - b. Consist of the following four (4) character types:
 - i. Uppercase alphabet characters (A through Z)
 - ii. Lowercase alphabet characters (a through z)
 - iii. Arabic numeric characters (0-9)
 - iv. Non alphanumeric characters (for example: !, \$, #, %)
 - c. Not be identical to the previous passwords

Instructions to reset your password:

- 1. Use the following link to access California FLccSC https://cas.fcdslms.med.miami.edu
- 2. Click 'Forgot Password' on the FLccSC sign in page.
- 3. You will be directed to a page asking for your email. Once you click **"Click here to receive email instructions to reset your password"**, the system will send you an email containing a code and open a page where you can enter the code and create your new password.
- 4. Open your email and copy the code. You will paste the code on this page in addition to creating a new password based on the criteria above.
